Te-jutsu: Hand to hand combat system of the Warrior Elite of Feudal Japan. This style utilises punches, strikes, stand up and ground grappling, kicks, throws and take-downs. Fluid and fast, this art retains many of the circular techniques which originate from the Southern Chinese arts introduced to Okinawa and blended with the local fighting styles.

Ken-jutsu: Techniques of the Katana, sword of the Samurai. Training is done with both the Bokken, wooden training sword for partner work learning blocks and counter strikes, and a Shinken, the live blade Katana, for learning drawing and cutting in one motion and honing the many cutting strikes. You will feel the power the Katana exudes when you train with this beautiful weapon.

Kobu-jutsu: The weapon art of the old peasant warrior of Okinawa. Bo (long staff) Ni Tanbo (two short staff) Nunchaku (flail) Tonfa (handled short staff) Sai (three pronged fork). Learn to utilise anything you can grasp, as a weapon.
