#### **1<sup>st</sup> Youth Olympic Wushu Tournament: 6-21 August 2014 Nanjing China**

This year marks an exciting time for the International Wushu Federation (IWUF) and wushu with the Nanjing 2014 Youth Wushu Tournament and the Nanjing Sports Lab Showcase taking place in conjunction with the Nanjing Youth Olympic Games later this month. #### **6<sup>th</sup> World Traditional Wushu Championships: 23-29 October 2014 Chizhou, Anhui Province China**

The event will be held from October 23 to 29, in Chizhou China, right before the 1st World Taijiquan Championships in Chengdu China. Chizhou City is where the well-known Jiuhua Mountain is located and is a noted historical and cultural city. The Jiuhua Mountain is one of the four famous Buddhist Mountains in China. Its majestic natural beauty and superior ecological environment attract numerous visitors each year.

#### **1<sup>st</sup> World Taijiquan Championships: 1-4 November 2014 Chengdu City, Sichuan Province China**

Based on the successful organization of the World Taijiquan Classic in 2013, the 1st World Taijiquan Championships will be organized by the IWUF from November 1 to 4, in Chengdu China, right after the 6th World Traditional Wushu Championships and the 2014 International Wushu Judges Examination Course (Taijiquan).

During this time, the 30th IWUF Executive Board Meeting will also be held. The Championships cover a variety of Taijiquan styles and forms, including both competitive and traditional events. Taijiquan practitioners of different ages can find their competition events.

Chengdu citizens are very enthusiastic about Taijiquan and the city is also called the City of Taiji. It is our hope that the event will further promote and highlight Taijiquan. As the World Taijiquan Championships is a new IWUF competition system, the Competition Rules have been amended from time to time, after being reviewed by Taijiquan experts.

Within the Nanjing 2014 Sports Lab, the emphasis will be on showcasing the excitement of wushu and its different formats. With no competition taking place, spectators and athletes alike will be fortunate enough to see the sport at its top level performed by many famous names from wushu.

### INTERNATIONAL WUSHU FEDERATION APPOINTS EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT

#### **IWUF President Zaiqing Yu Appoints Anthony Goh, Current IWUF Vice President, to be Executive Vice President**

IWUF President Zaiqing Yu has appointed Anthony Goh, current Vice President of the IWUF, to be its new Executive Vice President.

The International Wushu Federation (IWUF) was founded in 1990 and accepted as an International Olympic Committee (IOC) member in 2002 during the Salt Lake City Winter Olympics. In recent years wushu has developed rapidly as an international sport and gained tremendous recognition in the sport world, especially since it was short-listed as a candidate for future Summer Olympics.

Thanks to the joint efforts of the international wushu community, the IWUF has laid a strong foundation over the last two decades for continued success. In recent years, the IWUF has worked hard to improve the quality and professionalism of its operations. Nevertheless, the Executive Committee feels that IWUF needs to attain a higher level of professionalism as a world class international federation.

As part of this development President Yu has appointed Anthony Goh, current Vice President to be the Executive Vice President. Goh has served on the IWUF Executive Committee since 1995, and has held the position of Vice President since 2003.

Goh is the founding president of both the USA Wushu-Kungfu Federation (1993-present) and the Pan American Wushu Federation (1995-present). He was also the host and organizer of the 3rd World Wushu Championships held in 1995 in Baltimore, Maryland, USA.

President Yu stated, "I look forward to having Anthony as the chief executive for our operations. Anthony brings his vast experience and wealth of knowledge in both executive and grass roots levels in our sport, which is extremely valuable."

Goh's duties will include planning, developing and executing new and existing projects and programs, marketing and promotions, management of sponsors, staff management, and overseeing IWUF's general operations. Goh's position will become effective August 1st, 2014.

**NOTE:** The IWUF Executive Board includes President Yu Zaiqing (China); Five Continental Federation Vice Presidents: Europe (Raymond Smith); Oceania (Glen Keith); Africa (Beshir Elardawei); Asia (Kee Yong Wee); Pan-America (Anthony Goh) - as well as other Executive Members.
